April is here and your Year-End Reports are due to your District Presidents by the 10th of this month! Department chairman you should have all reports by the 20th. I would like your final report to me by the 30th of April please. Also remember all deadlines and Audits. This is very important. Be on time please.

Mid-Year conference was a blast and a stompping good time. Weather was cool but nice. Watch for the proposed changes to the National Bylaws which will be on the National website April 1.

Health and Happiness: some Auxiliaries are not sending the amount per member. So this is down by almost \$30,000. So please make sure you are sending in the correct amount. National Home has had some issues with burst pipes (due to extreme cold weather) and security issues. Yes I said security. National Home, if you have never been, there is no check in you just drive in and go where ever you like. Homes have come to a threat of break ins. They are checking in on security options to protect the homes. Security for our National Home was the last thing anyone would have thought would happen. This is suppose to be a safe haven for our Military Families. So we might want to think of something big to do to help. Also Life Memberships to the National Home will be going up next January to \$50 and this will include a pin.

The Council voted and approved membership pay outs to increase by \$.45 per member per level. It was announced that the following States that are closing in on 100% in Membership – Delaware, Alaska, Alabama,

Arizona, Florida, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Indiana, New Jersey and Ohio. So Texas needs more. Get out and find the ones that have not paid their dues. If someone has not been back for a few meetings find out why. We need to retain members and get them to come back and get them interested in our programs. This is a Challenge and I know we can do this!! We owe this to our Veterans and the Flag that they fought for. Honor Veterans we joined under by our love and kindness to all.

We have male members that are eligible and Texas is behind in the count. So look at the membership wheel and see what we can find. When you get out and help the Post with the Buddy Poppy drive set up for Membership as well.

These are presented at our State Convention. Each Auxiliary or VFW Post member who secures 20 new and/or rejoined members from July 1, 2017, to April 30, 2018, with the official form received at VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters no later than May 31, 2018, will be honored with a National Membership Achievement Award presented at the National Convention in 2018. Department Treasurers are not eligible. Make sure you send the form into National Headquarters to get your pin! The member must submit the form. The pin is another way to start a conversation with a potential member. So, finish up that challenge! Then you will be helping to "Catch the Dream for Our Veterans"!

The quick easy way to process your membership would be to utilize MALTA. You can use it anytime, just remember to send any **New** or **Rejoin** applications to the office after they have been input. The files need to be updated. If you work transmittals by sending to the office, **Do Not Hold!** Keep up the good work in **Recruiting**, **Rejoining and Retaining** members. One of the most important things to remember when recruiting new or rejoining members is that you need to follow up. Remember to contact them to see how they are doing, ask if there is anything you can help them with and keep them informed of upcoming events. Let them know they are **appreciated as a volunteer!** A heartfelt thank you can do wonders!
